1	A Black Forest Linden wood carved bear stand. 19th century, with inset glass eyes and supporting a tree trunk mounted with an oval top, height 49.5cm. There are two ring marks on the top. There is evidence of a little woodworm, but this does not appear to be active. No damage or losses to report.
2	An American cast iron Boston Terrier doorstop. With original painted finish, height 27cm. There is no damage to report. There is paint loss overall on what appears to be the original finish, with some rust, particularly around the paws.
3	A Victorian mahogany writing box. With a fitted interior, width 45cm, together with another similar mahogany writing box, a walnut writing box and a Remy Martin writing box (4).
4	A heavy Victorian brass door stop of Brittania. The figure cast in a typical pose upon the bow of a ship, height 43cm.
5	An Aboriginal woomera. (Spear thrower), with an integral hook, length 72cm.
6	A Greek carved cane. Made from olive wood, the handle formed as a horse's head, with a bearded male face and 'Kepkypa' carved to the back, length 87cm.
7	A cased set of Glockenspiel bells Late 19th century, comprising 14 silvered bells contained in a mahogany box, height 15cm, width 60.5cm, depth 26cm.
8	A French gilt bronze inkwell. 19th century, with a hinged lid, supported by three winged female sphinx figures, height 14cm, together with a Continental gilt and porcelain mounted desk timepiece (2).
9	An Angolan carved hardwood bust of a woman. Carved 'M. Rafael' to the top and 'Amo' to the front, height 46cm.
10	A French S.A.M. brass carbide car lamp. Early 20th century, model No 208, diameter of lens 21cm.
