1	An Edwardian stained mahogany knee-hole desk, the rectangular top with writing inset, and three frieze drawers above six pedestal drawers, 120 x 59cm.
2	A stained pine tool box fitted with trays and brass carrying handles, 95cm wide, together with a newel post, a circular table and a commode.
3	A Globe Wernicke-style three-tier stained mahogany bookcase with base drawer, 86cm wide, 106cm high.
4	A 1940's Art Deco-style oak case chiming grandmother clock, 138cm high.
5	Two oak-cased striking wall clocks, 76cm, (2).
6	A pitch pine bookcase, the open shelves above a pair of panel doors, 127cm wide, 204cm high, (cornice lacking).
7	An enamelled top pine food preparation table, the rectangular top with brass edges above two end-drawers, on turned legs, 93 x 63cm.
8	A 19th century pine tool chest, 94cm wide, and a dockyard-made hardwood display cabinet, (2).
9	Three 1930's oak dining chairs, a barley-twist drop leaf table and a Victorian dressing table mirror.
10	A Victorian mahogany button back salon chair.
11	A Georgian mahogany drop leaf dining table with two oval leaves on square tapered legs, 154 x 124cm.
12	After R O Lenkiewicz, "Self Portrait", unsigned coloured print, 125 x 77cm.
13	A Georgian style mahogany bow-fronted two-door wardrobe with dentil cornice and base drawer, 116cm wide, 208cm high (base cracked and small veneer losses to doors).
14	A 19th century mahogany corner washstand, 58cm wide and a 19th century mahogany rectangular three-tier washstand fitted with a drawer, 39cm wide, (2).
15	A Hong Kong carved wood folding circular occasional table and a walnut purdonium, (2).
16	A Victorian inlaid rosewood coal box with brass fittings and shovel.
17	A pair of Victorian upholstered dining chairs, two Edwardian salon chairs and two occasional tables, (6).

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- 22 A painted metal garden-table of pierced foliate design, 140cm long, together with eight chairs and a circular metal garden-table.
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- 23 A stained pine two-door wardrobe, 123cm wide, 207cm high.
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- 24 A Trek Navigator bicycle.
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- 25 A Raleigh pioneer 140 bicycle.
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- 26 A Yamaha electronic piano, P140, with stand, in carrying case.
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- 27 A Turkey runner, 266 x 75cm and two Oriental rugs, (3).
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- 28 A Victorian mahogany hall chair, the solid back and seat on turned front legs and a Georgian Hepplewhite style dining chair, (2).
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- 29 A Walnut cased Vienna style wall clock, 100cm high.
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- 30 A 19th century mahogany banjo barometer with silvered dials, signed Bruce & MacDonald, Edinburgh, 100cm high, (tube in need of attention.)
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- 31 A modern anodised brass hanging snooker table lamp, 87cm wide.
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- 32 A small silk floral patterned hearth rug, 94 x 63cm, two other oriental rugs and a stained wood high chair.
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- 33 Three oriental rugs and a saddle bag (4).
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- 34 A modern Kargayee rug, 155 x 110cm and another rug, (2).
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- 35 An Indonesian carved wood model of a Komodo dragon, 100cm long, 38cm high, (some losses to toes).
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- 36 19th Century Continental School, "A Vase of Flowers Standing on a Plinth", oil on canvas, old re-lining, 60 x 50cm.
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- 37 W V Tippet, "Cattle in a Stream", signed watercolour, dated '79, 39 x 54cm, a framed set of military cap badges and a marine print, (3).
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- 38 A large coloured print, "Lord Kitchener of Khartoum", another of Wellington and Nelson, commemorating Waterloo and Trafalgar and other pictures.
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- 39 A framed watercolour, "Wells Cathedral", 25 x 35cm and other pictures.
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- 40 An early 20th century Chinese carved hardwood tray, the centre carved with the Devonshire Regiment crest, paper label verso, The Devon Regiment OCA Exeter Branch, Salamanca Club, 76 x 43cm.
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- 41 An early-20th century Persian hardwood square table with overall marquetry decoration, the top inlaid with mother-of-pearl in a symmetric design and raised on eight cut-away supports, 37cm square, 52cm high.
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- 42 A large quantity of annuals, including Eagle Annuals 1-5, mainly 1960's-1970's and a small quantity of 1930's women's magazines.
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- 43 A quantity of books, including WE Johns Biggles volumes, (no dust jackets) and Percy F Westerman.

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- 48 The Illustrated Family Bible, ed: John Kitto, 2 vols, eng plts. cf gt, 4to, nd; Twiss (Horace), The Public and Private Life of Lord Chancellor Eldon, 3 vols, frontis, hf cf gt, 1844 and other volumes, similar.
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- 49 C Rex James, "Landscape", signed watercolour, 33 x 52cm, another, "The Yealm at Puslinch", titled verso, 14.5 x 26cm and a pair, "Birch Trees and Water, 14.5 x 26cm, (4).
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- 50 A George III mahogany two-tier circular dumb waiter on turned column and tripod support, 57cm diameter, 85cm high.

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- 126 A Royal Doulton Brangwyn Ware baluster vase, (hairline crack), 24cm high, a Doulton Lambeth jardinière decorated with flowering shrubs, 19cm high and a continental pottery figural spill vase, (3).

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- 132 An early 20th century bronze hand bell with turned lignum handle, 26cm high.
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- 133 A Sinclair ZX Spectrum personal computer, boxed, (cassette lacking) and a collection of board games, etc.
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- 134 A Bossons plaster wall figure of a turbaned figure with horse, various carved wood boxes, plated ware and miscellanea.
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- 135 Two beaten copper jugs, a copper coaching horn, other metalware and plated ware.
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- 136 A Lladro figure of a young woman with plumed head dress and evening gown standing by a pedestal of flowers, no.D/13A, 34cm high.
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- 137 Six Lladro angelic figures, one playing a pipe, a group of three choristers and four others, (6).
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- 138 A pair of glass decanters and stoppers, 24cm high, a silver top glass sugar sifter of square hobnail form, on square base, 15cm high and other glassware.
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- 139 A pair of Decoro ceramic jardinières decorated with exotic birds and flowers, 17cm diameter, 16cm high (one with small chip) and other ceramics.
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- 140 A Chinese carved hardwood jardinière stand, the circular burr wood top, 20cm diameter, on five carved scroll legs joined by a pierced undertier, 30cm high and three smaller jardinière stands, 12cm diameter, (4).
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- 141 A modern Capo di Monte figure group, "The Barber" by Corti, 22cm high, another, "The Cobbler" and two others, (4).
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- 142 A WW2 steel helmet, a kukri knife with plated mounts, a pith helmet and other militaria and miscellanea.
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- 143 A large collection of McDonald meals toys and other plastic toys.
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- 144 Four 1960's Government issue nursing recruiting posters various vintage cameras and other items.
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- 145 Various plated cutlery and other plated and metal ware.
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- 146 A kit model of HMS Surprise, fully rigged with sails furled, 75cm long, 54cm high and two etchings.
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- 147 Seven modern Willow tree composite figures by Susan Lordi, boxed and nine collectors' plates.
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- 148 Various hand tools, a jewellery box, a government issue leather brief case and other miscellanea.
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- 149 Various metal models of cars, a Harris Tweed advertising sign, a riding hat and miscellanea.
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- 150 An Allervale Mottoware cylindrical mug, an A J Wilkinson Coronation wine flagon transfer printed with a map of the world for Emu Australian Wine and other ceramics and miscellanea.

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- 152 An African carved wood totem staff, 172cm long, a fur covered staff, 190cm long and a carved wood native mask, (3).
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- 153 R O Lenkiewicz, a signed invitation to The R O Lenkiewicz Retrospective at Plymouth Museum 1997, signed by the artist and Terry Waite, CBE, together with a programme for The Halcyon Gallery Exhibition and other Lenkiewicz related items.
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- 154 A walnut mantel clock, various picture books and miscellanea.
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- 155 A quantity of first day covers and postal postcards, etc.
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- 156 A pair of wrought iron candle holders, 35cm high, a stained wood nest of six drawers, (af), 35cm wide, 45cm high, various walking canes and other items.
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- 157 An early 20th century copper rose bowl of compressed circular form on dolphin feet, 21cm diameter, a pair of bronze and copper short candlesticks, various plated cutlery and miscellanea.
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- 158 Two Asian wall hangings decorated with embroidery and sequins, other textiles and a large fan.
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- 159 A collection of WH Goss and other crested ware, approximately fifty pieces.
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- 160 A Carltonware crested model 'HMS Minesweeper', inscribed The Victory of Justice Armistice of the Great War..... (Bournemouth coat of arms), 11cm long, an Arcadian crested model of a WWI tank with Corsham coat of arms, 11cm and an Arcadian hand grenade with Pontycymer coat of arms, 6.5cm high, (3).
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- 161 Two Beswick model horses, Mare, facing left, brown gloss (1 af), one other horse, af, a blue budgerigar, facing left, first version, (af, flowers chipped), and a jack Russell terrier, small, (5).
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- 162 A collection of thirteen various Beswick foxhounds, some af, and a standing fox, 6.5cm, (14).
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- 163 A pair of Victorian brass candle lustres, each with cut drops on black marble base, 25cm high, (cracks to glass collars), (2).
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- 164 A pair of Carl Zeiss Jena Jenoptem 10x50W binoculars in leather case.
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- 165 A Wiltshaw & Robinson Ltd 'Guinness is Good for You' advertising ashtray, transfer-printed with a drawing of Sam Weller by 'Phiz', 12cm diameter and a Goodyear rubber tyre and glass advertising ashtray, 15cm diameter, (2).
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- 166 A chrome plated timepiece in the form of a ten-spoke ships wheel on stand, the dial with Arabic numerals and "UJS" trade mark, 20cm diameter, 33cm high.
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- 167 A small metal-coopered oak barrel with brass tap, on stand, 17cm long, an oriental hardwood stand, 15cm diameter and a small piece of driftwood modelled as a bird, on a stand, (3).
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- 168 A mid-20th century gilt metal cubic weather station on oval stand with hinged side panels for barometer, thermometer, 8-day clock and hydrometer, inscribed I M Hof swiss to clock diameter, 22cm high and a Kein 8-day clock under glass dome, 22cm high, (2).
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- 169 A Grimwades "Byzanta" ware lustre shallow bowl, the interior decorated with flowers and butterflies, 28cm diameter, 6.5cm high, together with a Hancock & Sons Rubensware "Pomegranate" lustre vase, 16cm and a similar baluster vase, 14cm high, (3).
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- 170 A pair of 19th century gilt metal and porcelain candlesticks, each gilt metal sconce and bottle-form ceramic column painted with flowers, raised on circular gilt metal base and feet, 24cm high, (2).
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- 171 A Moorcroft 'Fairy Rings' pattern ovoid shape vase decorated with toadstools on a blue and mottled ground, design by P Richardson, factory marks and 'WM' monogram to base, 18.5cm high.

187	A silver four-branch trumpet shaped epergne on circular loaded base, 25.5cm high, Birmingham 1921 and a small pair of silver spill vases, marks rubbed, (3).
188	Two 19th century miniature watercolour sketches in mahogany frames, 12 x 10cm, a hardwood truncheon and other items.
189	A collection of four geometry part-sets, slide rules, a Brown & Sharp no.46 micrometer and one other.
190	A modern necklace of uniform cultured pearls, 50cm long.
191	A Titan Regalia gent's quartz dress watch, the square black face, 22mm wide, with black-plated stainless steel case and bracelet, boxed with papers dated 2006.
192	Citizen, an Eco-Drive quartz wrist watch 'Sky Hawk', the black dial with Arabic numerals, subsidiaries and digital displays, in stainless steel case 41mm diameter, on stainless steel bracelet, boxed with paperwork.
193	A sovereign ring set an 1863 sovereign, in 9ct gold mount, size V, 19.7g.
194	A sovereign ring set a 1911 sovereign, in 9ct gold mount, size O, 20.9g.
195	A Continental open-face key-wind pocket watch, the white enamel dial with Roman numerals and seconds subsidiary, in engine-turned case and a silver napkin ring, (2).
196	A cultured pearl pendant set in 14ct gold, on 9ct gold chain, a pair of 9ct gold earrings, (total gross weight 4.2g) and a quantity of costume jewellery.
197	A gold-mounted double-sided locket and an engine-turned locket, (glass missing), (2).
198	A silver-cased open-faced key-wind pocket watch, the white enamel dial with Roman numerals and seconds subsidiary, a ladies Continental silver-cased pocket watch and a silver neck chain.

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- 203 Four freshwater pearl necklaces, two amethyst bead necklaces, a malachite bead necklace and other bead jewellery.
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- 204 A small silver spray brooch set two rubies, a modern hand-made bracelet set turquoise and other silver and white metal jewellery, some stone-set, gross weight ___8.18oz.
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- 205 A silver-backed hand mirror with heavily-embossed bird, mask and floral decoration, Birmingham 1916, an embossed-back clothes brush and hair brush, an engine-turned silver-backed mirror and two silver-topped glass jars, (6).
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- 206 A silver mustard, (liner lacking), a silver spill vase, three napkin rings and two ashtrays, (a/f), various dates and makers, weighable silver ___8oz.
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- 207 An Indian white metal hexagonal salt with embossed foliate decoration, two handles and raised on six twin-fish legs, 76mm wide, 64mm high.
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- 208 A string of jade coloured hardstone beads with silver clasp.
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- 209 Six small sterling silver coasters, 7cm diameter and a quantity of silver flatware, 18oz.
