1	A late-19th century mahogany bow-fronted chest of two short and three long cockbeaded drawers, on turned legs, 101cm wide, 105cm high.
2	A mid-20th century walnut sideboard, the rectangular top with low back, above three central drawers flanked by two cupboard doors, on turned feet, 153cm wide.
3	An Edwardian mahogany bathroom wall mirror, the plate above a hinged rectangular compartment and towel rail, 71 x 39cm overall.
4	An Edwardian mahogany bookcase, the rectangular top above a pair of astragal-glazed doors, on base with short cabriole legs and paw feet, 110cm wide, 149.5cm high.
5	An early-20th century oak roll-top desk, the interior fitted with drawer and pigeon holes over a central drawer flanked by seven pedestal drawers, 128cm wide.

8	An Edwardian mahogany wardrobe, the cornice above a pair of mirrored doors, on a two-drawer base, 153.5cm wide, 207cm high, a mahogany wash stand fitted with a mirror and a mahogany sideboard base, 153cm long.
9	A 20th century three-seater Knole settee, with gold-coloured upholstery and braiding and with loose cushions, 209cm wide and a similarly-upholstered armchair, (2).
10	A reproduction gilt overmantel mirror, 91 x 138cm.
11	A late-19th century oak oval tip-top occasional table on triform base, 68.5 x 54.5cm and a 5' 6" modern pine bed frame, (2).
12	A large modern Chinese rug with deep blue borders on a camel-coloured ground, 279 x 184 and a smaller Chinese rug, 196 x 94cm, (2).
