2	A Kenwood patissier electric food mixer. CONDITION REPORT: In used condition, but generally good.
3	A Zenit EM SLR camera wirth lens and leatherette carry bag. CONDITION REPORT: In used condition but generally good.
4	Three modern beech wood effect wall mirrors, each of rectangular form. CONDITION REPORT: Some scratching to the frames but overall good condition.
5	A Hoover 22 volt lithium battery hand held vacuum cleaner, lacking attachments or charging cable.
6	Two decorative floral prints, in silvered frames, glazed. 29.5 cm x 29.5 cm. CONDITION REPORT: In good used condition with some slight fading and discolouration.
7	An Aerial photograph of St Bees village, taken from a helicopter on Sunday May 26th 1985, pine framed, 53 cm x 76 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Some marks to frame and some slight discolouration, but generally good.
8	A modern cream painted rectangular wall mirror, the overall dimensions are 82 cm x 61 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Generally in good used condition, with some minor corner scuffing.
9	A group of four reproduction Chinese vases, the largest measuring 40 cm. CONDITION REPORT: In used condition but generally good.
10	A early 20th century walnut aneroid barometer of ships wheel design. 22 cm diameter. CONDITION REPORT: Generally in good used condition.
11	A Llangollen stoneware vase, of ribbed cylindrical form. 31 cm high. CONDITION REPORT: Rim chip, otherwise good condition.
12	A group of 11 Heron cross reproduction pottery tea pots, each of chintz or floral decoration. CONDITION REPORT: In good condition overall.
13	A collection of modern Bristol blue glassware's, including three bottles and four pasta storage jars. CONDITION REPORT: In used condition but generally good.
14	A box of Denby Arabesque dinner ware. CONDITION REPORT: In used condition, the base marks are faint.
15	A quantity of miscellaneous books, to include Art Deco by Beavis Hillier, and some local themed books. CONDITION REPORT: All in used condition with some page yellowing, bending, damage to dust jackets etc.

- 16 An early 20th century oil on canvas, depicting a country thatched cottage. Signed E.Dixon and dated 1927 lower right. Held within a gilt moulded frame. 44 cm x 29.5 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Some surface soiling and some small holes to the upper right corner and to the lower right corner. Some minor ...[more]

- 17 A 1930's Art Deco blue and white painted three piece bedroom suite, comprising dressing table, chest of drawers and cupboard. CONDITION REPORT: Obviously later painted with some discolouration to the paint work and some wear and paint losses.
- 
- 18 A Vibra power vibration machine complete with power cable. CONDITION REPORT: In used condition with some scuffing etc, but overall good condition.
- 
- 19 Two chromed bar stools, with leather effect seats. 82 cm with a seat height of 68 cm. CONDITION REPORT: In used condition with some blistering to the chrome plating and some corrosion showing through.
- 
- 20 A pair of imported Mexican pine bedside cupboards, with black painted fittings. 67 cm x 54 cm x 39 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Splitting to the tops, one split the entire width. Some edge knocks etc, but overall generally good.
- 
- 21 A pair of 1930's walnut bedside cupboards, 69 cm x 33.5 cm x 32 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Marks and staining to the tops, each cupboard as one side that has been replaced with ply board. Each has corner knocks etc.
- 
- 22 A modern chrome effect glass topped coffee table with x-form leg arrangement.
- 
- 23 A Wolf electric super hot steam cleaner. CONDITION REPORT: In used condition, appears good.
- 
- 24 An Hinari refresh air, air conditioning unit. CONDITION REPORT: Some yellowing to the plastic casing, otherwise appears to be good.
- 
- 25 A modern leather effect electric recliner chair, complete with AC/DC adaptor. CONDITION REPORT: Used condition with some staining to the surface.
- 
- 26 A late Victorian/Edwardian corner washstand, in stained pine. 101.5 cm x 73 cm x 58 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Some staining and fading to the top, each side would have had some attachments, those are now missing.
- 
- 27 An Edwardian mahogany dressing chest, with bevelled arched mirror over an arrangement of drawers. Width 107 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Some minor ring marks to the top, some corner knocks etc, but generally good.
- 
- 28 Two modern pine double beds, of standard double bed size. CONDITION REPORT: In used condition and requires assembly. showing signs of use with marks and scratches etc.
- 
- 29 A modern pine effect six piece bedroom suite, comprising dressing table, wardrobe, and four bedside chests. CONDITION REPORT: In generally good used condition with some minor signs of use.
- 
- 30 A tall slender white painted bookcase, with adjustable shelving over an arrangement of open sections. Dimensions 213 cm x 62 cm. CONDITION REPORT: In used condition with some staining and paint losses but generally good.
- 
- 31 A pair of Bausch & Lomb mark 1 765 US Navy binoculars, dated 1941, leather cased. CONDITION REPORT: In generally good used condition, some wear to the edges etc and some scratching to the leather case.
- 
- 32 A selection of crested wares,wade whimsies, Staffordshire figure and two fairings. CONDITION REPORT: Some ware to the gilded rims on the crested wares, some crazing to the Staffordshire figure but otherwise age appropriate ware and condition.

- 33 A silver plate and oak horse shoe form ink stand, together with a pewter capstan style ink stand. CONDITION REPORT: The horseshoe ink stand generally in good condition with some tarnishing to the plated mounts and the pewter has some knocks to the rim.
- 
- 34 An embossed leather sewing box, together with five other small boxes. CONDITION REPORT: All in used condition, the embossed leather with some deterioration, marks and scratches etc to the others.
- 
- 35 A 19th century French oval alabaster paperweight, with painted miniature to the matrix. 9 cm x 7.5 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Some chipping to the moulded rims and some wear and repaired crack to the base rim.
- 
- 36 A Victorian Monocular microscope, 11 cm. CONDITION REPORT: It does have a knock to the eye piece rim and has ware to the brass work.
- 
- 37 A group of four pocket watches, to include the exactimure H Samuel pocket watch, Smith's pocket watch and a West clock's pocket watch. CONDITION REPORT: All in used condition with some staining to dials and wear etc to cases.
- 
- 38 A 19th century white metal cased fob watch, together with two winding keys. CONDITION REPORT: The watch is missing its glass and is tarnished throughout. The case back is showing some minor opening damage but otherwise good condition.
- 
- 39 A Victorian linen scroll map of Northumberland. CONDITION REPORT: A degree of damage throughout, showing some worm damage.
- 
- 40 A 1930's /40''s oak wall clock, with Arabic hours. 75 cm x 32 cm. CONDITION REPORT: In used condition with some staining etc. The clock is retaining its pendulum and key.
- 
- 41 An early 20th century oak and decorated embossed card two fold screen. 74 cm x 56 cm. CONDITION REPORT: The embossed card is warped and has a degree of staining and are some small depletions to the applied moulded decoration.
- 
- 42 A box of miscellaneous costume jewellery, to include simulated pearl necklaces, paste set brooch etc. CONDITION REPORT: Each in used condition with some staining and age related wear.
- 
- 43 A Victorian pottery 3 piece toilet set, comprising jug, bowl and soap dish. Together with a W & E Corn Ironstone toilet jug. CONDITION REPORT: The toilet jug has damage to the base and chips to the rim, the toilet bowl has wear to the rim and the soap dish has minor chipping and wear.
- 
- 44 A set of four Victorian balloon back dining chairs, with drop in seats. 89 cm with a seat height of 47 cm. CONDITION REPORT: One chair with damage to the front legs, the remaining chairs are showing signs of some old repairs but generally good.
- 
- 45 A selection of miscellaneous silver-plated and steel cutlery. CONDITION REPORT: All in variant states of oxidization etc.
- 
- 46 A selection of miscellaneous glassware's to include etched 19th century glass rummer's, salts ,twisted glass vases, crystal jug etc. CONDITION REPORT: In used condition some showing damage.
- 
- 47 A small 9ct gold locket, together with a selection of miscellaneous white and yellow metal jewellery. CONDITION REPORT: All in used condition in varying states of tarnishing etc.
- 
- 48 A selection of silver-plated wares, to include rose bowl, basket, plated stag figure, teapot etc. CONDITION REPORT: All in used condition with some denting ware, tarnishing etc.
- 
- 49 A group of four 1930's and later mantle clocks, to include Smith's Enfield Bakelite case mantle clock. CONDITION REPORT: Generally in good used condition with some minor edge wear and scratching.

- 50 Two large clay pipes, the largest with printed name Robert Sinclair, Old Tobacco, Nun Street, Newcastle, together with a stained wood pipe rack, with poker work decoration. CONDITION REPORT: The pipes appear to have some age and have some scratching and soiling. The pipe rack again with signs ...[more]
- 
- 51 A Victorian pottery butterfly pattern tea pot (damaged), together with a 19th century blue and white sponge ware pottery cup. CONDITION REPORT: The tea pot is crazed and stained throughout with some chipping to the rims and large crack running from the spout to the base.
- 
- 52 An Owens of Hereford glass soda syphon, a Boots Chemists glass feeding bottle, a J Kershaw & Sons of Gateshead glass bottle and a silver mounted cut glass scent bottle. CONDITION REPORT: Some oxidation to the soda syphon's mount, some chipping to the cut glass scent bottle, the Boots feeding ...[more]
- 
- 53 A 19th century papier mache and brass mounted three bottle cruet set, of shaped triangular form, containing wheel cut condiment bottles. 21 cm high. CONDITION REPORT: Some slight movement to the structure, some cracking to the papier mache surface but generally good condition for age. The brass ...[more]
- 
- 54 Two antique elliptical form box irons, with wooden handles. Together with a small selection of old keys. CONDITION REPORT: Some corrosion etc, loose handles to the irons.
- 
- 55 A carved Japanese bamboo page turner, with depiction of an immortal in front of Mount Fuji. 40 cm x 4.4 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Some signs of wear but generally good condition throughout.
- 
- 56 A group of three vintage confectionary tins, one containing a small collection of costume jewellery. CONDITION REPORT: Some wear and paint losses to two tins, the larger tin does have some scratching.
- 
- 57 A garnet set yellow metal stick pin, a yellow metal mounted shell cameo brooch, and a yellow metal locket and chain. CONDITION REPORT: Each in used condition with some signs of oxidation etc.
- 
- 58 A vintage cream enamelled bread bin, of typical form. 31 cm x 35 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Some enamel losses to the cover with some corrosion showing.
- 
- 59 A vintage blue enamelled bread bin, of traditional form. 33 cm x 41 cm x 25 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Paint losses and scratching throughout with corrosion showing.
- 
- 60 Two early 20th century barley twist oak string seated stools, together with a roll of seating string. CONDITION REPORT: One stool with extensive damage to the string seat, each with marks and scratches to the exposed frames.
- 
- 61 A Victorian drop dial mahogany regulator wall clock, by J. Marshall of Blaydon, the dial with Roman hours, enclosing a subsidiary seconds dial and makers details. 81 cm in height. CONDITION REPORT: Some wear and staining to the dial, some minor joint separation to the case and some wear to the tr ...[more]
- 
- 62 A quantity of miscellaneous china and glassware, to include art deco flower basket and vases, painted opaque glass vases, and some reticulated foliate decorated plates. CONDITION REPORT: Some damage apparent, mainly to one glass painted vase.
- 
- 63 A late Victorian hand stitched patchwork quilt, with harlequin pattern, opposed by stripes, hand quilted in stylized foliate decorations. 227 cm x 192.5 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Some fading mainly to the outer edges, minimal staining otherwise generally good condition commensurate with age and use.
- 
- 64 A large late 19th/early 20th century patchwork quilt, with paisley or boteh design material, hand stitched in repeating design. 223 cm x 197 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Generally good condition throughout with minimal staining. The quilting is hand-stitched but the seem and construction appears to be ...[more]

- 
- 65 A vibrant blue and gold material hand machine stitched patchwork quilt, constructed of stripes and hand quilted with goulash designs. 226 cm x 222 cm. CONDITION REPORT: In good mused condition with minimal wear and staining.
- 
- 66 A Victorian red and white striped hand stitched patchwork quilt, quilted with guilloche and chevron designs. 240 cm x 230 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Blocks of staining throughout, mainly to the white material, but generally good condition.
- 
- 67 A Victorian style machine stitched quilt, constructed of foliate and pink material and quilted in scallop shell designs. 225 cm x 197 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Appears to be in good condition. With minimal staining and wear.
- 
- 68 An Otterburn rug, hand woven (Northumbrian village industry) woollen blanket. In a tartan type design. 225 cm x 185 cm. CONDITION REPORT: In good used condition throughout.
- 
- 69 An early 20th century occasional table, in the moorish style. 52 cm x 30 cm x 30 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Some wear mainly to the top edges etc and some minor worm damage showing. One foot has a small depletion.
- 
- 70 A Victorian amber glass and patinated metal oil lamp, together with two chromium plated oil lamps. CONDITION REPORT: Each with oxidation, one with bending to the shade stand.
- 
- 72 A vintage enamel washbowl and jug.
- 
- 73 A Day & Sons original universal medicine chest, in pine. With paper label to the interior and printed to the front. 12.5 cm x 43 cm x 24 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Marks and scratches to the top and to the exterior, some staining to the interior.
- 
- 74 A Main 72B calor gas two ring hob, in cream enamel. CONDITION REPORT: Some signs of use and some enamel losses and corrosion, some corrosion to the removable rings.
- 
- 75 Three boxes of miscellaneous china and plated wares etc. CONDITION REPORT: A degree of damage throughout.
- 
- 76 A Victorian coloured lithograph of sheep, within a moulded gilt frame, glazed. 44 cm x 69.5 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Some discolouration and fading, the print surface is warped slightly. The frame has some cracking and minor losses.
- 
- 77 A Victorian painted pine 2/2 chest of drawers, with raised 3/4 gallery. 89 cm x 97 cm x 49 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Marks and scratches throughout, with some edge knocks etc and some damage to the base moulding and re-attached legs. The middle drawer has one handle missing and the rear right leg is ...[more]
- 
- 78 An early 20th century oak three drawer chest, 81 cm x 98 cm x 45 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Marks and scratches to the top, the top is lacking its gallery or splash back. Some damage to the base rail.
- 
- 79 An 1950's cream painted and yellow melamine topped kitchen utility cupboard, with two drawers and two cupboard doors. 82 cm x 91 cm x 40 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Some splitting and warping to the melamine top, some paint wear and staining to the exterior.
- 
- 80 A late Victorian/Edwardian stained pine 2/4 chest of drawers, with serpentine fronted top. 122 cm x 99 cm x 51 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Split to top and heavily scratched with losses to the finish, the drawer fronts are scratched as well has the sides.
- 
- 81 An 1950's oak Neatette kitchenette, with glazed upper cupboards and enamelled work surface. 176 cm x 87 cm x 46 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Some marks and scratchers and wear, signs of use to the work surface, some water marks etc, but generally good.
- 
- 82 A linen Bacon's 20th century map of Northumberland and Durham, with part of the joining Counties. (coloured). CONDITION REPORT: Some discolouration and tears, but generally in fair condition, commensurate with age.

- 
- 83 A bundle of six walking sticks, one with silver cap. CONDITION REPORT: All in used condition, with a degree of wear and scratching.
- 
- 84 An Edwardian mahogany octagonal occasional table, with turned supports and galleried under shelf. 73 cm x 60.5 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Generally good used condition, some minor scratching but otherwise good for age.
- 
- 85 A Victorian coloured lithograph, of a Eagle & Stag on a rocky out crop. Within a moulded gilt frame and glazed. 50 cm x 74 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Some discolouration and some slight warping to the print. The frame generally in good condition.
- 
- 86 A Victorian coloured print, entitled "Papas keep sake", within an oak Oxford pattern frame. 62.5 cm x 44 cm. CONDITION REPORT: The print is in generally good condition, some accumulated dirt under the glass in the lower right corner, the print has lost its backing board and has been crudely re-ba ...[more]
- 
- 87 A late Victorian coloured lithograph, after W Watson. Depicting highland cattle, within a moulded gilt frame and glazed. 45 cm x 68.5 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Some warping to the print and some losses to the moulding on the gilt frame.
- 
- 88 Two early to mid 20th century frameless mirrors, one of oval form, the other of arched rectangular form. 44 cm x 57 cm & 66.5 cm x 41 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Some spotting to each frame, mainly to the arched rectangular.
- 
- 89 A 1940's oak utility sideboard, with two drawers and two cupboard doors. 105 cm x 117 cm x 43.5 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Some marks and wear to the top and to the drawer fronts and door fronts also.
- 
- 90 A 1940's oak bow fronted sideboard, the top with demi lune recess. 93 cm x 121 cm x 45 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Some marks and scratches, edge knocks and wear, the top is loose.
- 
- 91 A box containing two part tea sets, one gilt and white and the other florally decorated. CONDITION REPORT: Some evident damage but generally as expected.
- 
- 92 Two vintage blue enamelled flasks, one retaining its stopper, together with a selection of miscellaneous glass, to include to Derbyshire style recumbent lions, and a selection of cut throat razors and hair trimmer's. CONDITION REPORT: Some enamel loss and corrosion showing to the larger flas ...[more]
- 
- 93 A Deans pottery Lusern wash bowl, and a large quantity of mixed china. (contained in six boxes). CONDITION REPORT: All in used condition with some damages.
- 
- 94 Two bundles of stair rods, together with a selection of clips and fasteners. CONDITION REPORT: In used condition, but generally good.
- 
- 95 A pair of French field binoculars, marked Grand Lumiere Paris, leather cased. CONDITION REPORT: Some compression to the eye piece surrounds and some wear and denting to the lens apertures. The leather case with wear, but generally in good condition.
- 
- 96 A Vintage woven wicker basket, together with a vintage glass thermometer by James Rudd, 41 Exmouth Street, London, W.C.1, housed in the original card tube. CONDITION REPORT: Damage and worm damage to the basket, the thermometer is intact, however it is doubtful if it is fully working.
- 
- 97 A mid century light oak two piece bedroom suite, comprising wardrobe and dressing table. CONDITION REPORT: Generally in good used condition, some minor scratching and edge knocks etc.
- 
- 98 A Empisal knit master SRP-60N knitting machine, together with an Empisal knit master LC2 attachment and various other sewing related items, together with a smaller knitting machine and knitting machine table. CONDITION REPORT: The Empisal machine looks to be in good used condition and retains ...[more]

- 99 Am oak linen fold dresser base, in the priory oak style. 81 cm x 136.5 cm x 44.5 cm. CONDITION REPORT: The top is lacking, marks and scratches to the top and water marks etc to the drawer and door fronts.
- 
- 100 A 1980's stained oak display cabinet, or bookcase. In the priory oaks style. 101 cm x 105 cm x 33 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Some marks and scratches to the top and some slight blistering to the left-hand edge. Some marks and wear to the door fronts.
- 
- 101 A box of miscellaneous china, to include Wedgwood Jasper ware, Russian dove figure, and Franklin porcelain Royalty figurines. CONDITION REPORT: Used condition, some minor signs of damages.
- 
- 102 A box of miscellaneous china, to include a Prattware pot lid (as found), figurines (as found), crested ware etc CONDITION REPORT: Some damages etc.
- 
- 103 A box of miscellaneous china, to include a reproduction Chinese lidded jar, the base of a 19th century ginger jar, a Royal Doulton Sandyman decanter, and four Goebel Friar jugs and tankards. CONDITION REPORT: The Sandyman decanter lacking its stopper and one Goebel jug with damage and one tankar ...[more]
- 
- 104 A Victorian Mother of Pearl inlaid papier-mache box, with gilt foliate and inlaid decoration. 6 cm x 31 cm x 25.5 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Some losses to the Mother of Pearl inlay and wear to the gilded decoration. The hinges are loose and there is damage to where they were fixed. There is deterior ...[more]
- 
- 105 Two boxes of miscellaneous soft goods, to include towels, curtains and bed sheets. CONDITION REPORT: All in used condition, but appear to be good.
- 
- 106 A glazed oak display case or bookcase, circa 1940. 123 cm x 91 cm x 30 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Some fading wear and scratching to top and some scratching to the door fronts and scuffing to the base etc.
- 
- 107 A group of five vintage wristwatches, to include Atlantic Star flash, Timex automatic, Larex, Ingersoll, and a Mudu 20 jewel. CONDITION REPORT: The Mudu with scratches to the glass but retaining its mate-o-style strap, the reminder with marks, scratches to the cases and glass and each lacking a ...[more]
- 
- 108 A selection of various pens, to include a Waterman's green pen, and a Platinum propelling pencil. CONDITION REPORT: All in used condition.
- 
- 109 A selection of silver-plated flatware, mainly spoons. CONDITION REPORT: Tarnishing wear, scratching etc
- 
- 110 A stained oak glazed corner cupboard, in the priory oak style. 100 cm x 76 cm x 38 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Some marks and scratches, edge knocks etc. The lead glazed doors have some bowing and compression.
- 
- 111 A 20th century reproduction Rococo style wall mirror, with sinus foliate scrolls. 90 cm x 56 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Some minor wear to the frame with some accumulated residue.
- 
- 112 A 1920's oak knee hole writing desk, with central drawer, flanked by two smaller drawers. 76.5 cm x 108 cm x 52.5 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Some marks and scratches mainly to the top, some wear and scuffing etc.
- 
- 113 A box of miscellaneous sundry items, to include a pen knife, a Claude Valentini wristwatch, Queens own Hussars cap badge etc. CONDITION REPORT: All in used condition, the wrist watch the bracelet is damaged.

- 117 A late Victorian walnut framed nursing chair, with carved foliate detail and turned front supports. 87 cm with a seat height of 34 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Some wear and discolouration and damage to the the upholstery, the top rail is showing some minor signs of worm damage. The lower exposed frame ...[more]
- 
- 118 A pitch pine church pew, of traditional form with triple panelled back, 88 cm x 235 cm x 39 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Generally in good used condition, with some minor splitting and losses to the ends and some minor joint separation, wear etc.
- 
- 119 A pitch pine church pew, with triple panelled back. 89.5 cm x 223 cm x 41 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Generally in good used condition with some signs of wear, some minor splitting to the ends.
- 
- 120 A set of four stained elm seated wheel back chairs, by Old Charm. Together with two similar design chairs, and a oak drop leaf table. CONDITION REPORT: Each in used condition with signs of wear, marks and scratches etc. The table with joint separation to the top.
- 
- 121 A pair of Edwardian string inlaid mahogany bedroom chairs, with serpentine fronted padded seats. 83.5 cm with a seat height of 43 cm. CONDITION REPORT: Some marks and scratches, staining and fading and minor damages to the padded seats, some slightly loose joints, and movement to the structure.
- 
- 122 An early 20th century oak barley twist palm or jardiniere stand, with cane panels. 91.5 cm high x 36 cm diameter. CONDITION REPORT: Some joint separation to the top and some moulding losses, the cane panels have some damage mainly compression and lack of tension. Some moulding losses to the feet.
